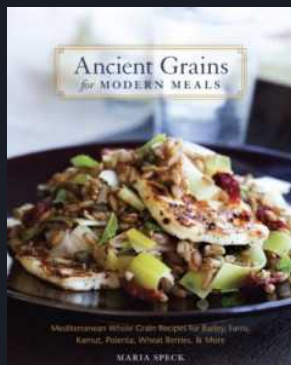
## Mahi Mahi Harbor Tour
